

Shredded Scrap Supplier Form

United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) regulations mandate that steel consumers take certain measures to minimize the amount of mercury in the shredded scrap metal that they melt. As a broker of the scrap metal that you produce, DJJ requires you to complete, sign, and return this form detailing the practices in place for the management of mercury switches from your process (check the applicable box).
